MTP means Master Train Plan and is a document detailing the distribution of Train Service Entitlements as advised by Aurizon Network from time to time for all Train Services and any Planned Possessions on a specified part of the Rail Infrastructure.

ITP means Intermediate Train Plan and is a plan that details the indicative scheduled times for all Train Services and Planned Possessions and Emergency Possessions on a specified part of the Rail Infrastructure on each day of the relevant period.

DTP means Daily Train Plan and is a plan which indicates all scheduled Train Services and Planned Possessions, Urgent Possessions and Emergency Possessions (to the extent known) for a particular day.

MTD means Month To Date.

All clause references are from Schedule G of Aurizon Network's 2016 Access Undertaking.

For clarity, the TSE consumption information in this report relates to scheduling and does not apply to take or pay calculations.
